Victor Harbor Railway Turntable

Introduction

On the 11th July 2018, a redeveloped railway turntable was opened at Victor Harbor. The site has undergone a dramatic transformation that not only pays tribute to the rich railway history of the coastal town but also provides an incredible public space that locals and visitors can enjoy.

Best Bricks and Pavers supplied a total of 270 square meters of the Best Paver 80 to complete the redevelopment. This paver is part of the traditional range, which perfectly pays homage to the glory days of the Victor Harbor railway.



Patterns

Laid in a 90 degree herringbone pattern, the Best Paver 80 Charcoal Honed perfectly reflects the history of the railway turntable.

The Best Paver 80 Claret Honed Pavers create the ideal border for the paved areas. Pavers boasting numbers of historical train numbers are littered throughout the paved area.

Tied In Beauty

The whole site redevelopment incorporates more than just refreshed pavers. Blue sheep that reflect the importance of the railway for transporting livestock, information signs under a shelter and historical fencing and gates all link to the rich history of the area. The pavers supplied by Best are able to compliment the rest of these features beautifully.
